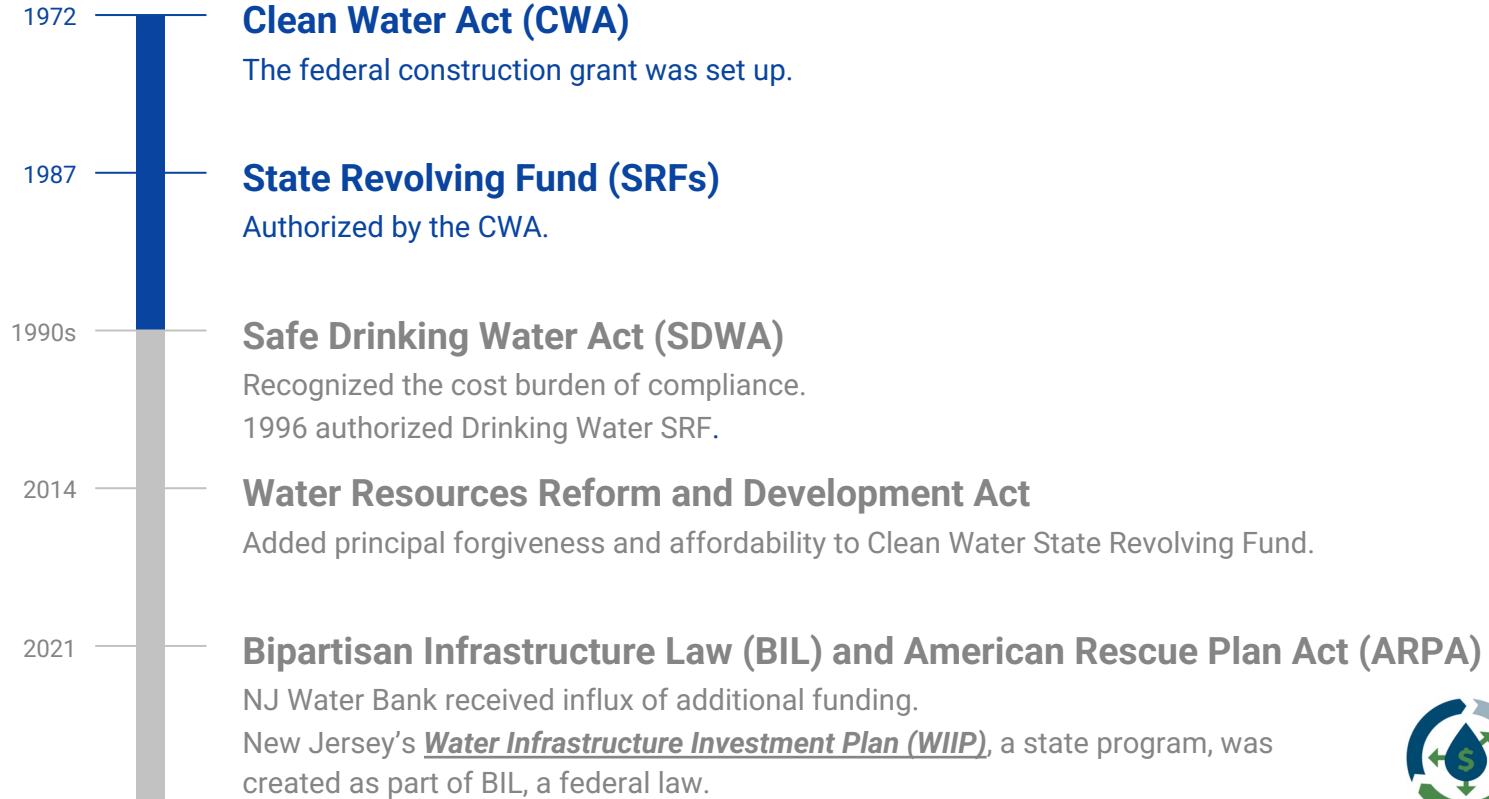

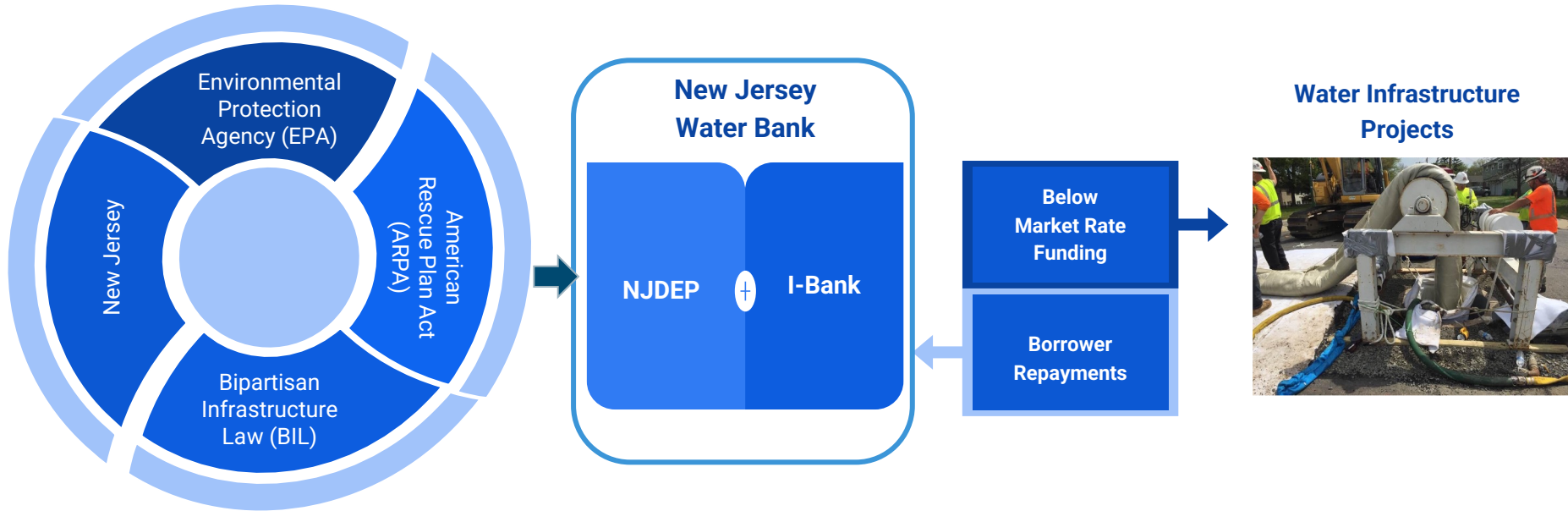

BACKGROUND - A brief overview of the funding (contd.)



Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL)

Clean Water Year 1

\$72MM

for any eligible clean water project

\$4MM

for projects that address emerging contaminants

Drinking Water Year 1

\$31MM

for any eligible drinking water project

\$49MM

for projects to address lead in drinking water

\$13MM

for projects that address emerging contaminants

Total Impact

\$440MM

BIL Program

+\$480MM

Existing Base Program will result in over \$900 MM

Over \$900MM of BIL and base SRF funds available for project funding each year over the next 5 years! (Source: NJDEP)
MM = millions of dollars

SFY23 Allocation of NJ's ARPA Funds to Make Transformative Investments in Water Infrastructure.
\$293 to SRFs for Project Funding - Must be awarded by 12/31/24 and expended by 12/31/26 (Source: NJDEP)



CHALLENGES



- Disparities existing in water infrastructure investments, particularly those in overburdened communities
- Systems lack the staff capacity and financial resources to navigate the process
- Insufficient funds to cover all project costs

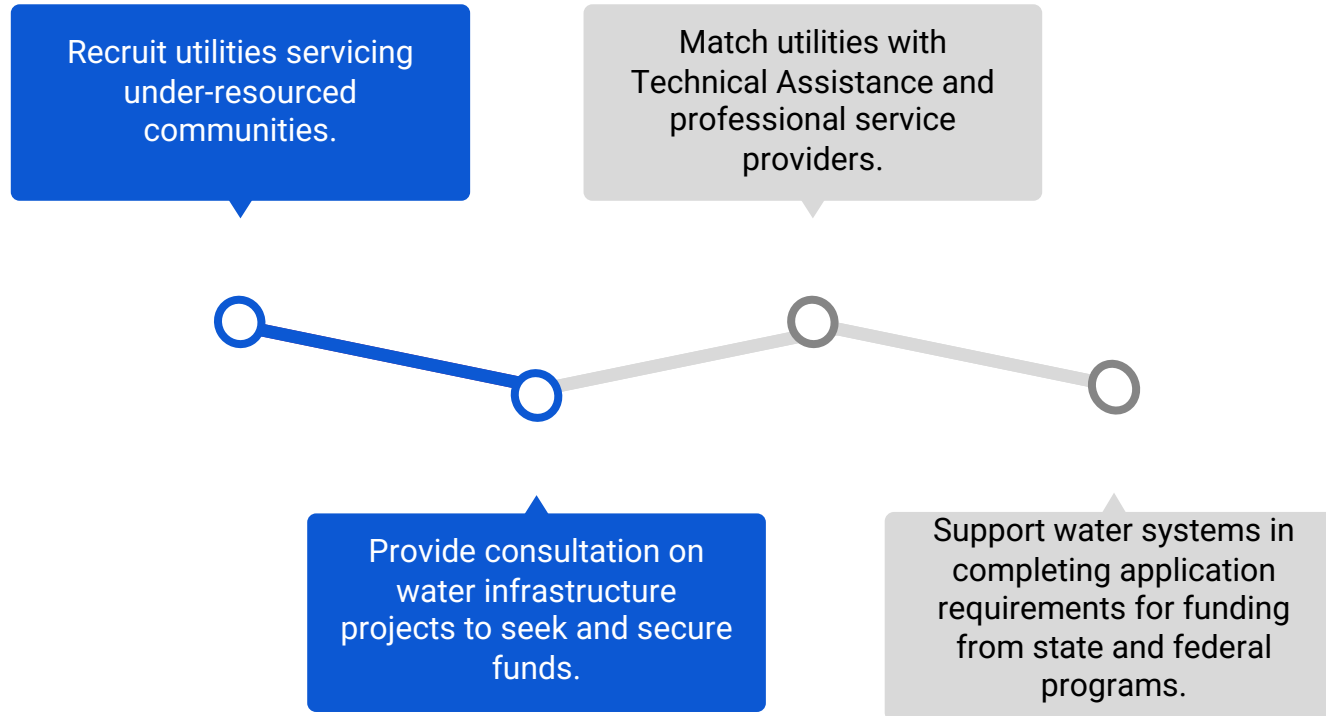

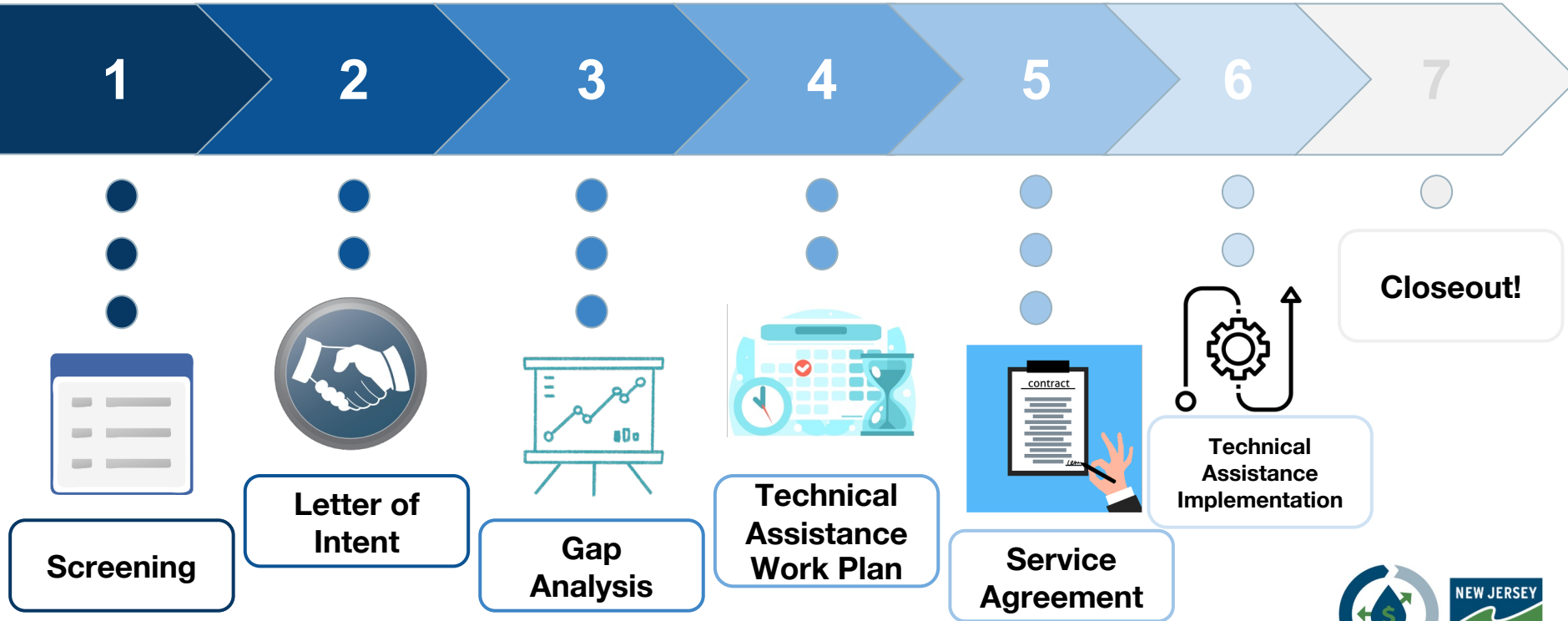
Finance better projects

PROJECT MANAGEMENT PROCESS

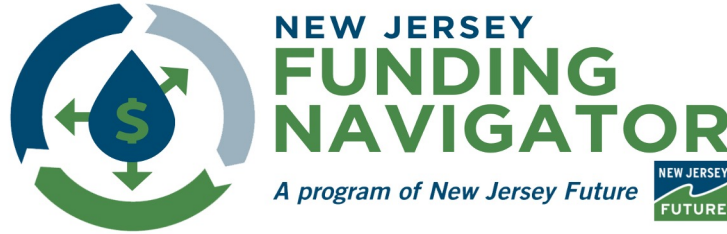
